



STORAGE TIPS

01

Use Jars

Use jars for storing dry goods, such as sugar, flour, beans, rice, pasta, etc. They also work well in for buttons, plns, and other craft supplies, or as Piggy Banks.

02

Use Pegboard

If you have a blank wall in your kitchen, craft room (or any other room) cut a piece of pegboard a coordinating or matching color. Use it to hang pots, pans, clothing, purses, etc.

03

'File' Your Space

Filing supplies, such as wire desktop systems work great for lids, dishes, and small trays. Magazine boxes can be used to stack water bottles, and even canned goods (lay them on their side and label the top so you know what it is!)

04

Plastic Storage Boxes

Use these as a 'craft kit' (keeps all the supplies for a single craft together); store open boxes of microwave popcorn, individually wrapped snacks, and more.

05

Egg Cartons

These work well in a craft room. Use them to separate button styles or colors, beads, or other small crafting item.
